STEP 1: APPLY ONLINE

Along with your name and email, select your Student Type (Graduate) to be directed to the application for your program.

STEP 2: REQUEST OFFICIAL TRANSCRIPTS

Send Official Transcripts from all previously attended college or universities

Electronic Transcript

Transcripts are only considered official if ordered through a third-party transcript service such as Parchment or Clearinghouse. Please choose HIU on the portal or send to hiuadmissions@hiu.edu.

Coursework Evaluation upon acceptance into program
Combination of above

PAYMENT OPTIONS
