- \* Graduation Rate is the program's Advertised Length of Completion, which is how long the program is designed to complete as written. HIU's Advertised graduation rate is 2 years. Students can choose a three-year program to spread the number of courses each semester. About 40%-50% of students choose to complete the program in 3 years, which is a full-time track. Due to students the percentage of students who complete the program on the three-year track, the graduate rate for the advertised timeframe is lower than the maximum graduation rate.
- \*\* Job Placement Rate is the percentage of graduates from the cohort year that are employed utilizing skills learned in the COAMFTE accredited program.
- \*\*\* Licensure rate is the percentage of graduates from the cohort year that have achieved ANY level of MFT licensure. For Master's programs only, COAMFTE has established a benchmark of 70% licensure rate for each cohort.
