Programs are only required to provide data on the past 7 years/cohort or since the program was initially accredited, whichever is shorter.

- * Graduation Rate is the program's Advertised Length of Completion, which is how long the program is designed to complete as written. HIU's advertised graduation rate is 2 years. Students can choose a three-year program to spread the number of courses over each semester. About 40%-50% of students choose to complete the program in 3 years, which is a full-time track. Due to students, the percentage of students who complete the program on the three-year track, the graduate rate for the advertised timeframe is lower than the maximum graduation rate.
- ** Job Placement Rate is the percentage of graduates from the cohort year that are employed utilizing skills learned in the COAMFTE-accredited program.
- *** Licensure rate is the percentage of graduates from the cohort year that have achieved ANY level of MFT licensure. For Master's programs only, COAMFTE has established a benchmark of 70% licensure rate for each cohort.
