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Financial Aid

Students attending Hope International University who wish to receive financial aid, in addition to meeting other eligibility criteria, must be in good academic standing and making satisfactory academic progress in their degree or certificate program.

Quality of Progress (Good Academic Standing)

• Students requesting aid must maintain a minimum cumulative GPA as follows:

3.25 annual	Presidential and Gold Level Nicolas Jr. High AVID Scholarship Recipients		
3.0 annual GPA	\$12,000 Pacific, Ministry Honors, and Silver Level Nicolas Jr. High AVID Scholarship Recipients		
2.75 annual GPA	\$8,000 Pacific and Bronze Level Nicolas Jr. High AVID Scholarship Recipients		
2.5 annual GPA	Dean, Christian Leadership, and all other Avid Scholarship Recipients		
2.0 annual GPA	All Federal, State, and all other institutional aid programs not listed		

- GPA's are reviewed annually, except for students that have been admitted on probation. These students will have their GPA renewed after their first semester.
- Students who fail to maintain the minimum GPA will be suspended from financial aid until the GPA is raised to the required minimum. Students have the opportunity to appeal a financial aid suspension once during their attendance at Hope (approval of appeal is not guaranteed).
- Students admitted to the University with status other than "Clear" may be placed on Financial Aid Probation, or may be ineligible for aid until the minimum GPA, and/or other requirements are attained.

Quantity of Progress (Unit Completion Requirement)

Students receiving aid must make forward movement toward their degree completion as follows:

Undergraduates Full-time (12 units or more per semester) 3/4 time (9-11 units per semester) 1/2 time (6-8 units per semester)

- Unit completion is reviewed annually. Summer classes will be considered part of Fall semester; "J" and May term will be considered part of Spring semester for financial aid purposes.
- The following grades are considered to demonstrate satisfactory course completion: A, B, C, D, and Credit. Grades that do not demonstrate course completion are: F, No Credit, Incomplete, W.
- Students are eligible to receive financial aid for up to 9 units for repeat courses for which a failing grade was given. Student are eligible to receive financial aid once for repeat of a previously passed course
- Remedial or pre-requisite work may be considered if the course work is specifically prescribed by the student's academic advisor.
- Students who fail to complete at least 75% of the required number of units per academic year will be suspended from financial aid. Appeal forms should be submitted to the Financial Aid Office within 30 days of the date the notice of ineligibility is mailed to the student. Students may appeal for reinstatement once during their attendance at Hope.
- Failure to properly withdraw from school, producing "F" grades, may result in the return of financial aid.

Quantity of Progress (Maximum Time Frame)

• Students requesting aid are expected to complete their academic program within a reasonable time frame (including transfer units) as follows:

Undergraduates Full-time = 6 years (180 units attempted) Three-quarter time = 9 years (180 units attempted) Part-time = 12 years (180 units attempted)

• Time frame is reviewed annually.

All semester attended will be used in calculating quantitative progress regardless if financial aid was used at that time.
