HIU provides many opportunities for you to quickly plug into the amazing HIU community so that you can apply the experiences and credits you've earned at prior college(s) to your new campus community.



Our world is connected, bridging gaps between cultures and countries; at HIU we welcome and encourage our students to broaden their horizons inter-culturally. The International Student Programs (ISP) office provides a wealth of services to our international students and also provides educational experiences for our domestic students including diversity training, intercultural communication, and more, helping prepare them as informed citizens and global servant leaders.

### ENGLISH AS A SECOND LANGUAGE

HIU's College of Education provides training in the English language for international students seeking a study abroad experience in America. Our English as a Second Language (ESL) programs are for students who want to earn an undergraduate or graduate degree at a respected university but have limited English skills. ESL courses provide training in English for academic and business settings, while preparing international students to enter an American university.

At HIU, international students have the opportunity to create lasting friendships with American students and professors. Our professors have master's degrees in TESOL and the smaller size of our university affords us the unique ability to provide highly personalized attention and guidance to our students. Through HIU's ESL programs, students are prepared to pass the Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) and progress into a bachelor's or master's degree program at HIU.

### INTERNATIONAL STUDENT PROGRAMS

The ISP Office helps international students adjust to American culture and life by providing support and training. We help our students by offering conversation partners and providing other opportunities to connect with American students and with fellow international students. We also advise students on applying for social security numbers and driver's licenses, opening bank accounts, navigating the transportation system, and more so they can get the most out of their study abroad experience.

Because of our Southern California location in the heart of Orange County, we offer a long list of extra-curricular activities. The ISP office leads students on weekly field trips to amusement parks, shopping centers, museums, local events and more.

### DONGSEO UNIVERSITY PARTNERSHIP

HIU has a long-standing partnership with Dongseo University (DSU) in Korea, which is the world's largest Christian Church university. The two universities have exchanged students for study abroad experiences and have built a relationship that strengthens students' understanding of the world as a global society. DSU students live, study, and experience American life while studying ESL at *Hope*. DSU students contribute greatly to the multicultural setting at HIU, and *Hope* students are afforded the opportunity of studying at a leading university in Korea.

Hope International University was founded in 1928 as Pacific Bible Seminary. Since our founding, our mission has been to empower students to serve the Church and impact the world for Christ. Our first campus was located in Long Beach in 1937. In 1963, our name changed to Pacific Christian College. To accomodate our growh, we moved to a new campus in Fullerton in 1973. In 1997, we achieved university status and became HIU, reflecting our global orientation and the world-wide impact of our alumni.
